

Welcome to Fun with Paste, Volume I. In this printable, you will find eighteen cut-and-paste activities created to help your toddler and preschooler develop fine motor and problem-solving skills. The projects progress from the simplest ones with large shapes to more complex ones with smaller shapes. Simply print the activities that are right for your children, cut apart the pieces from the back portion of the book, and enjoy. You'll find important information on the projects and where to find their matching pieces below.

Page 4: Australian landscape—cut the four picture rectangles from page 23

Page 5: Ocean life—cut the three picture shapes from page 25

Page 6: Cold-weather animals—cut the three picture shapes from page 28

Page 7: Flowers with faces—cut the four flower faces from the top of page 22

Page 8: Butterflies—cut the two yellow dots and the four purple dots from page 22

Page 9: Ice cream—cut the five scoops of ice cream from page 27; instruct your child to build whatever size ice cream cone he or she wishes

Page 10: Girl with autumn leaves—cut as many of the leaves in circles as you need from page 24; have the child glue them randomly on the picture

Page 11: Horse—cut the six horse pieces from page 23

Page 12: Bird with birdhouse—cut the red birdhouse trim, the two yellow bird parts, and the two hearts from page 26

Page 13: Train with shapes—cut the six wheels and three shapes from page 23

Page 14: Circus tent—cut the giraffe, parrot, monkey's face, and two bush pieces from page 28

Page 15: Farmer—cut the two brown squares and the one blue and two gray rectangles from page 22

Page 16: Boy with kite—cut the bows from page 28. The bows are slightly bigger than the outlines on page 16 to provide for easier gluing.

Page 17: Playing in the rain—cut the umbrella top and two boots from page 24 and the two hands, two yellow pockets, and blue jeans from page 25

Page 18: Transportation—cut the cloud of smoke and the five variously-shaped pieces below it from page 25

Page 19: Happy car—cut the six car parts from the lower-right portion of page 26

Page 20: Boy with telescope—cut the two telescope parts, the pair of arms, and the small oval from page 25

BONUS: Page 21: Orchard scene—cut as many of the orchard pieces from page 27 as you wish; there are various sizes to allow for children of many ages to enjoy building the scene
