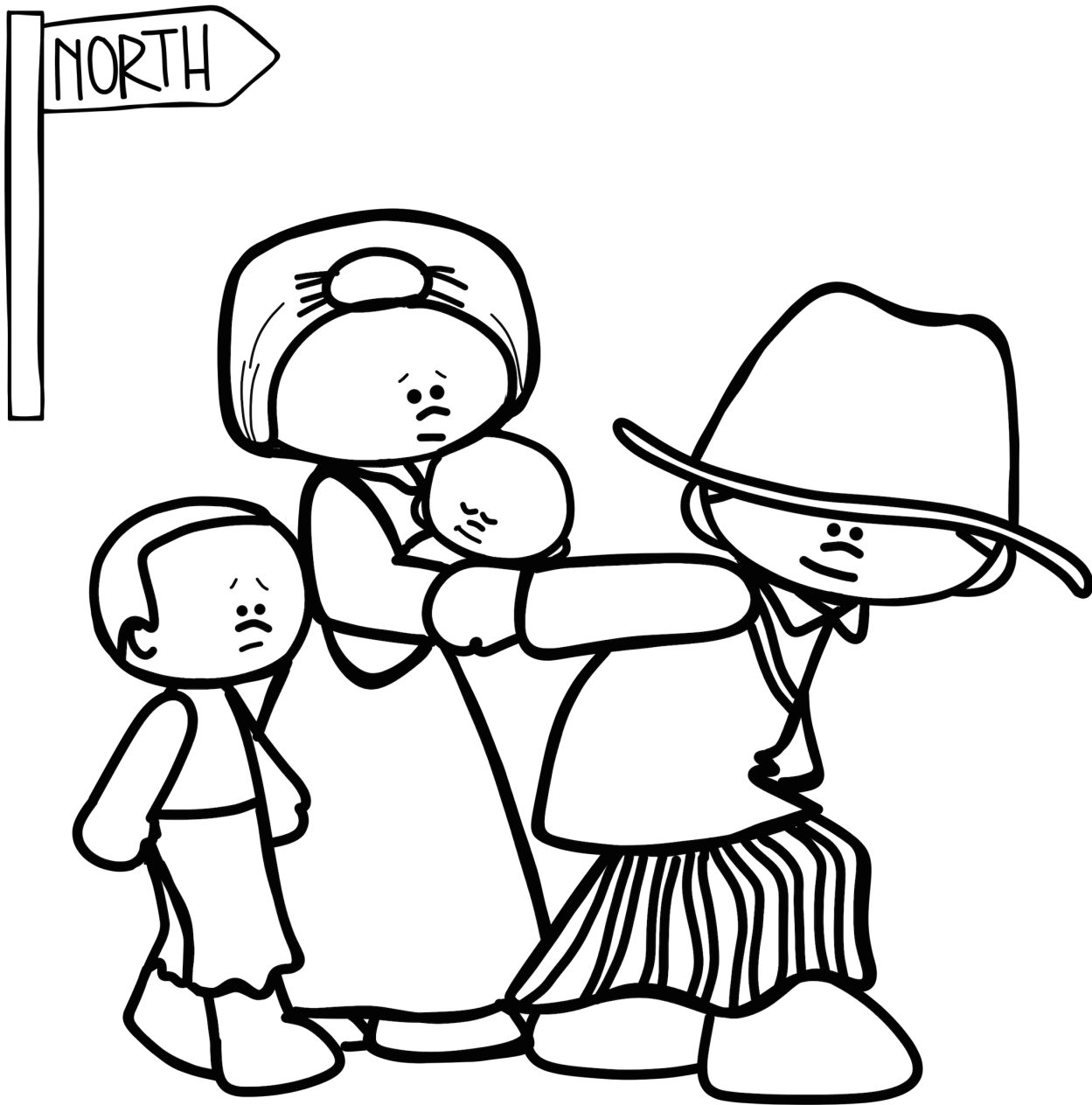
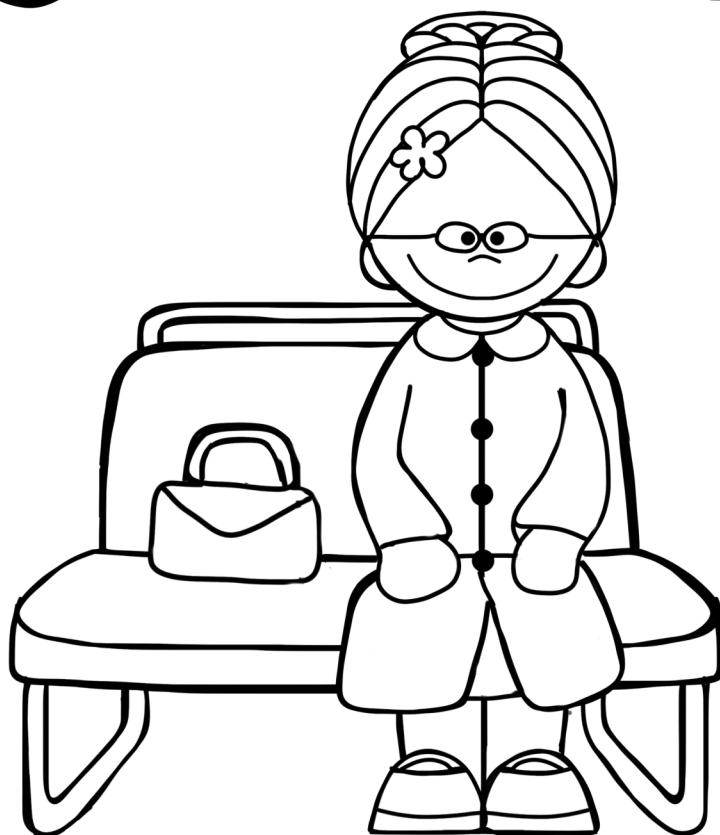
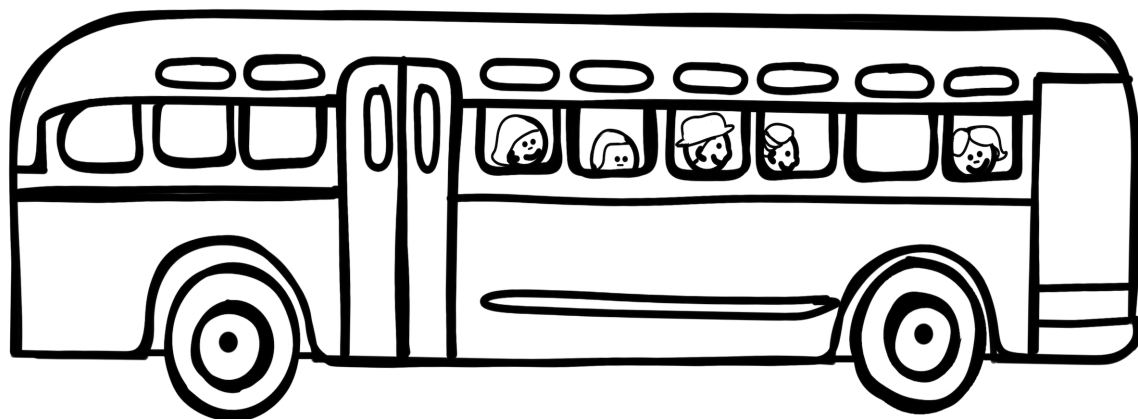




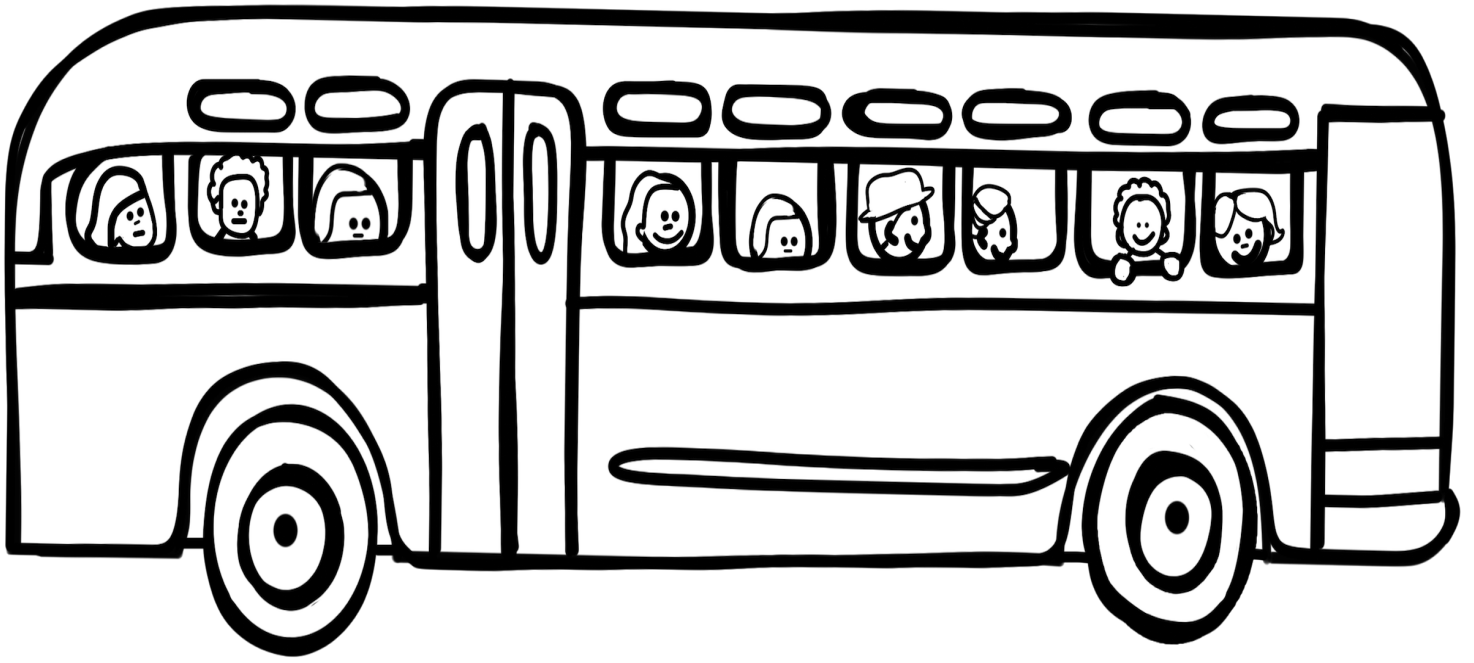
Harriet was named
