It is your first Thanksgiving in your new homeland of Canada. What are you thankful for this year, and how do you celebrate?

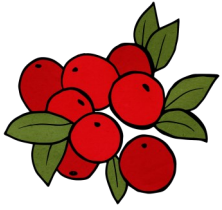




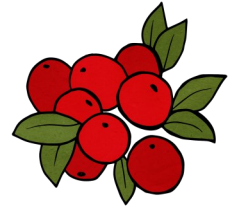
Writing Prompt #7

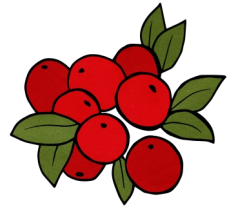
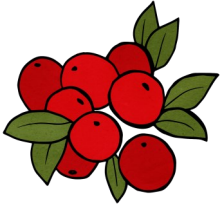
