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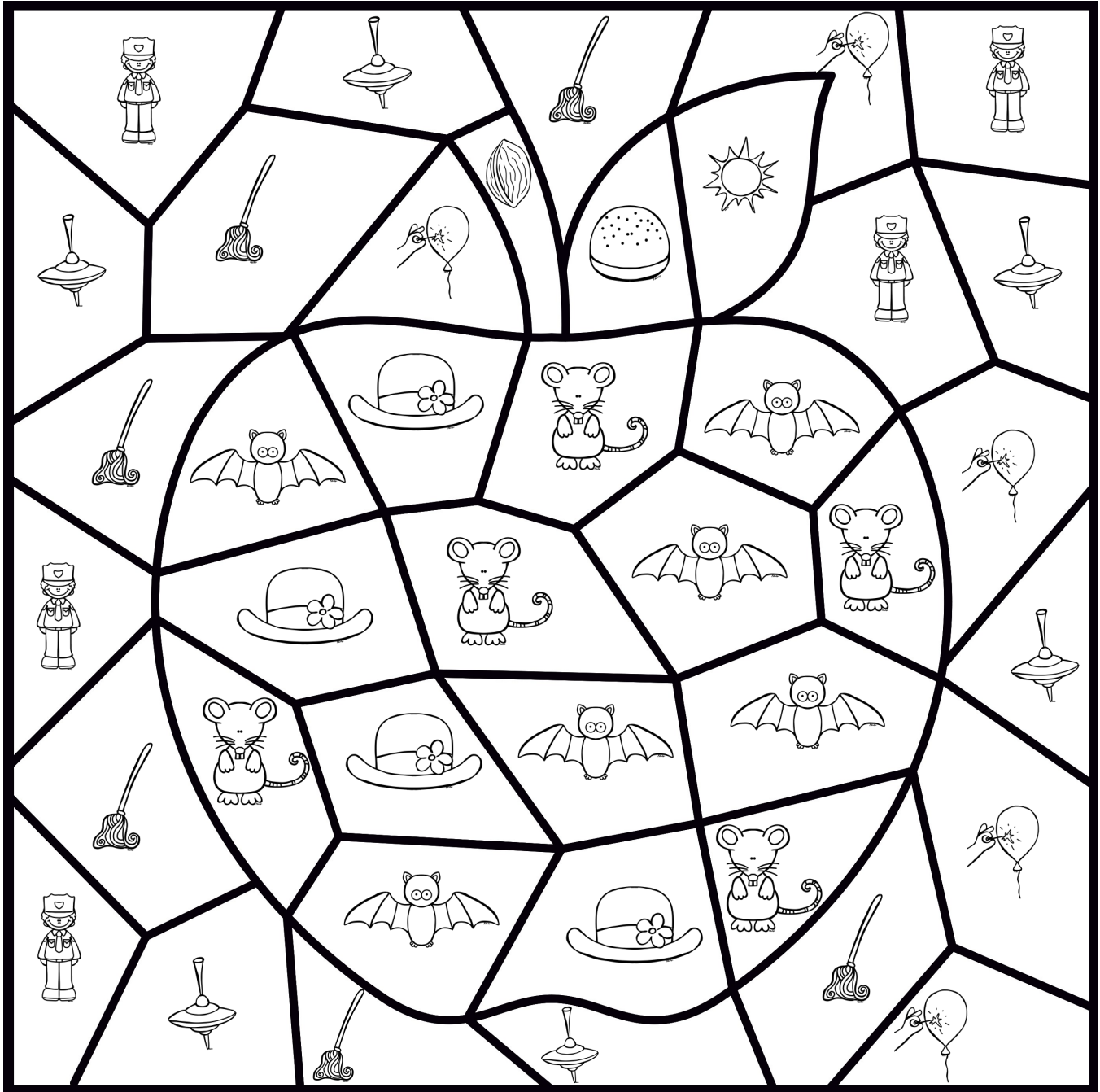
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How to Use This Book

These 105 preschool skills worksheets are arranged into 7 themes: fruit, animals, shapes, construction, birthday party, weather, and sports. You can use just the worksheets needed to study a specific theme, or work through all the themes to cover the full range of skills included. These worksheets explore rhyming words, number recognition, number words, shapes, seasons, color words, animal recognition, and fine motor skills. Activities include a range of color by activities, such as color by rhyme, color by shape, color by number, color by animal, and color by number word or color word, as well as mazes, tracing, patterns, counting, matching, dauber activities, and sequencing.

Use a dauber to make the picture of the circle. Imagine the circle is a group of people watching something going on in the middle. Draw something in the circle the people could be watching.



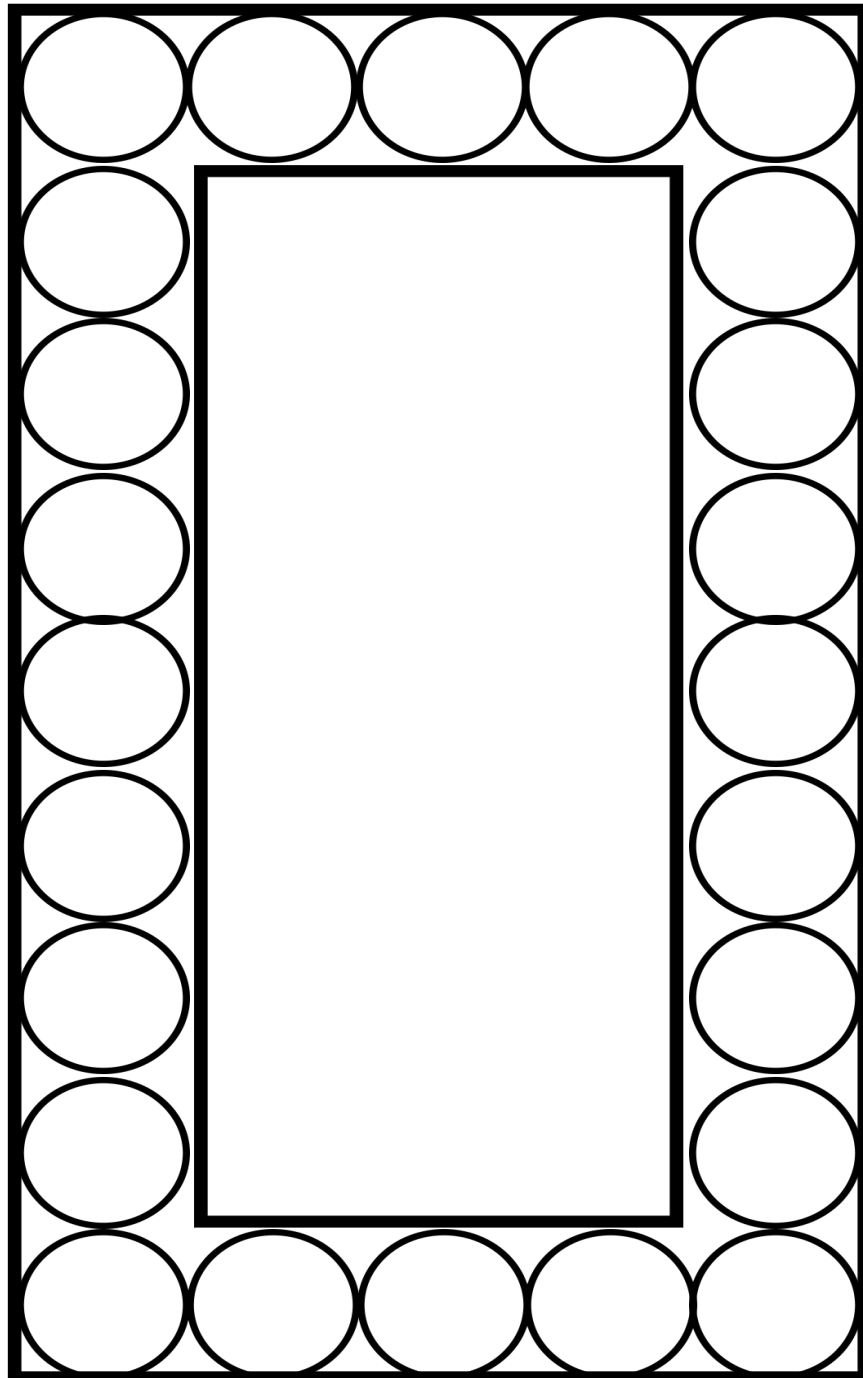

Use a dauber to make the picture of the oval. Imagine the oval is a picture frame. Draw a picture in the oval of something you would like to put in the frame.



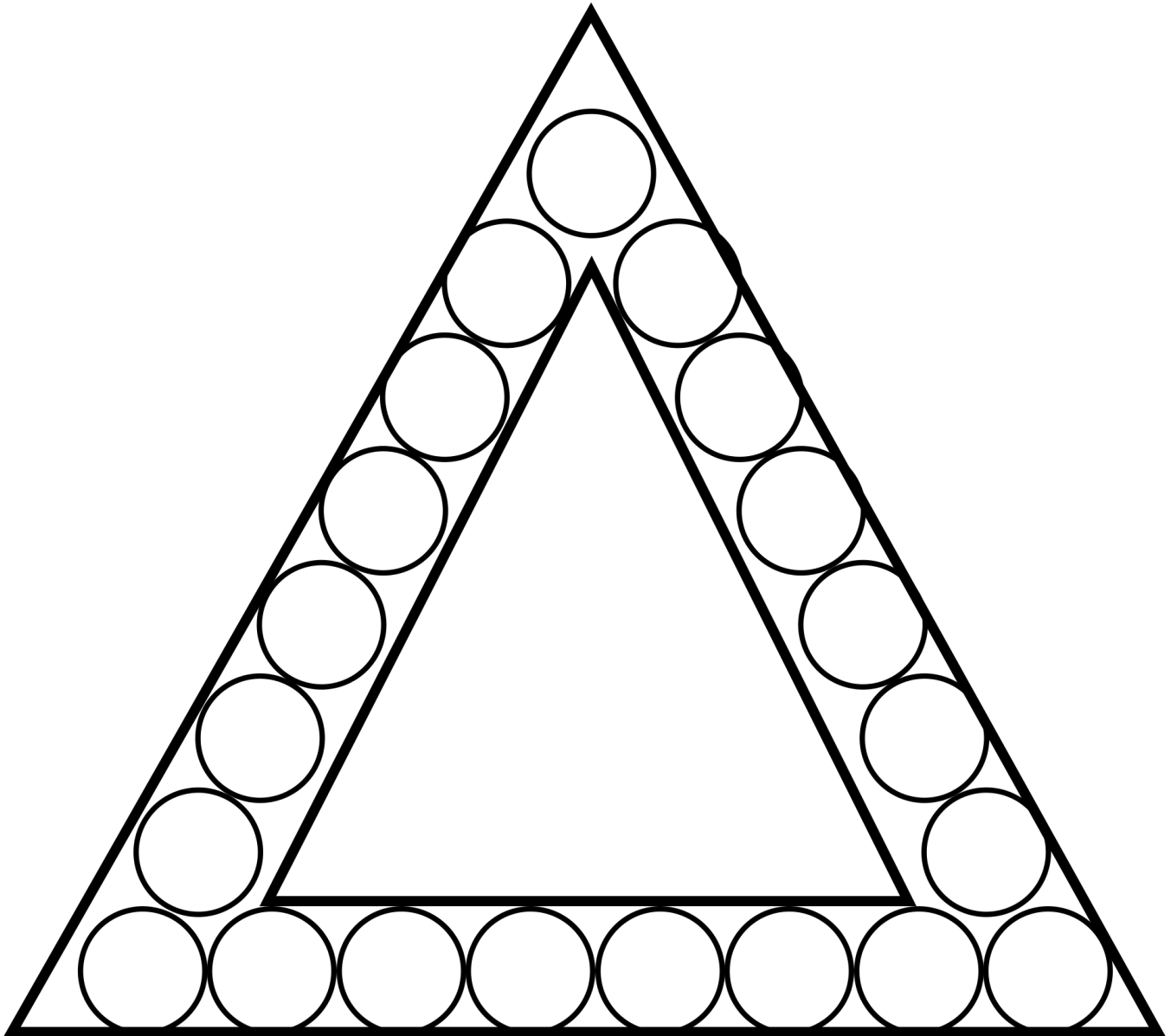

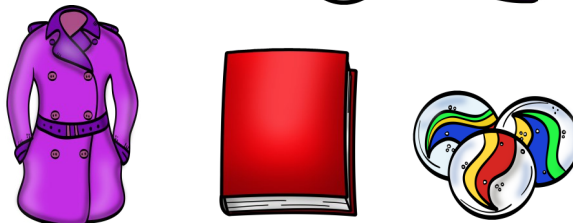
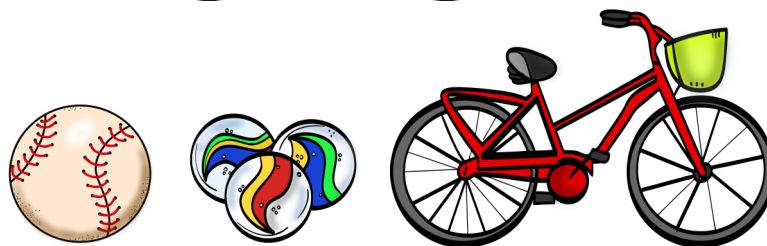
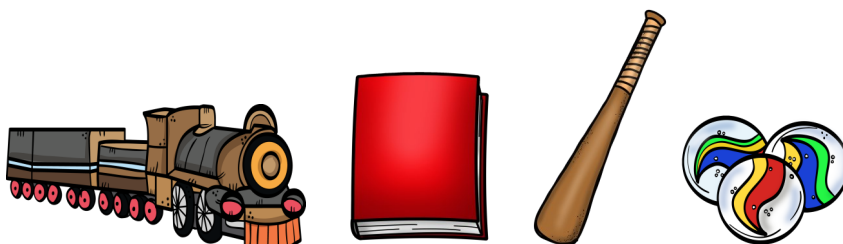
Baking a Cake

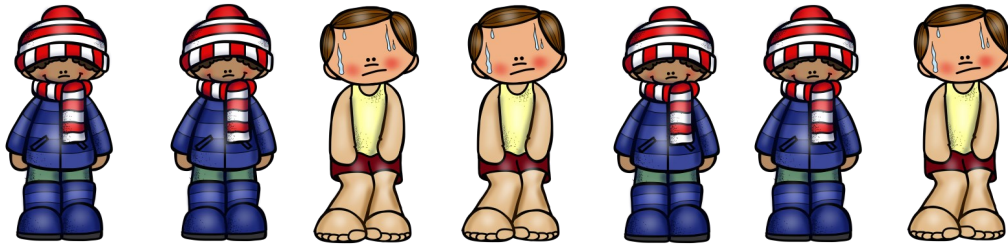

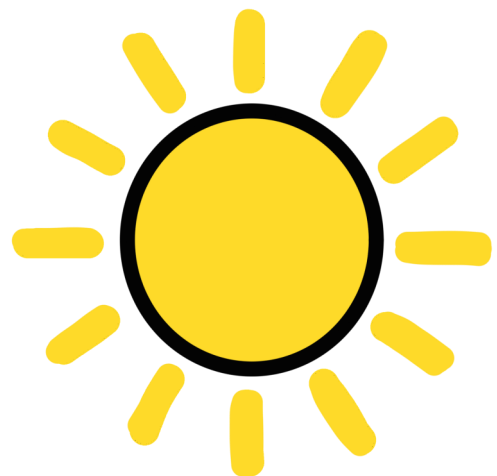
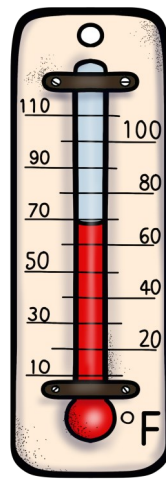




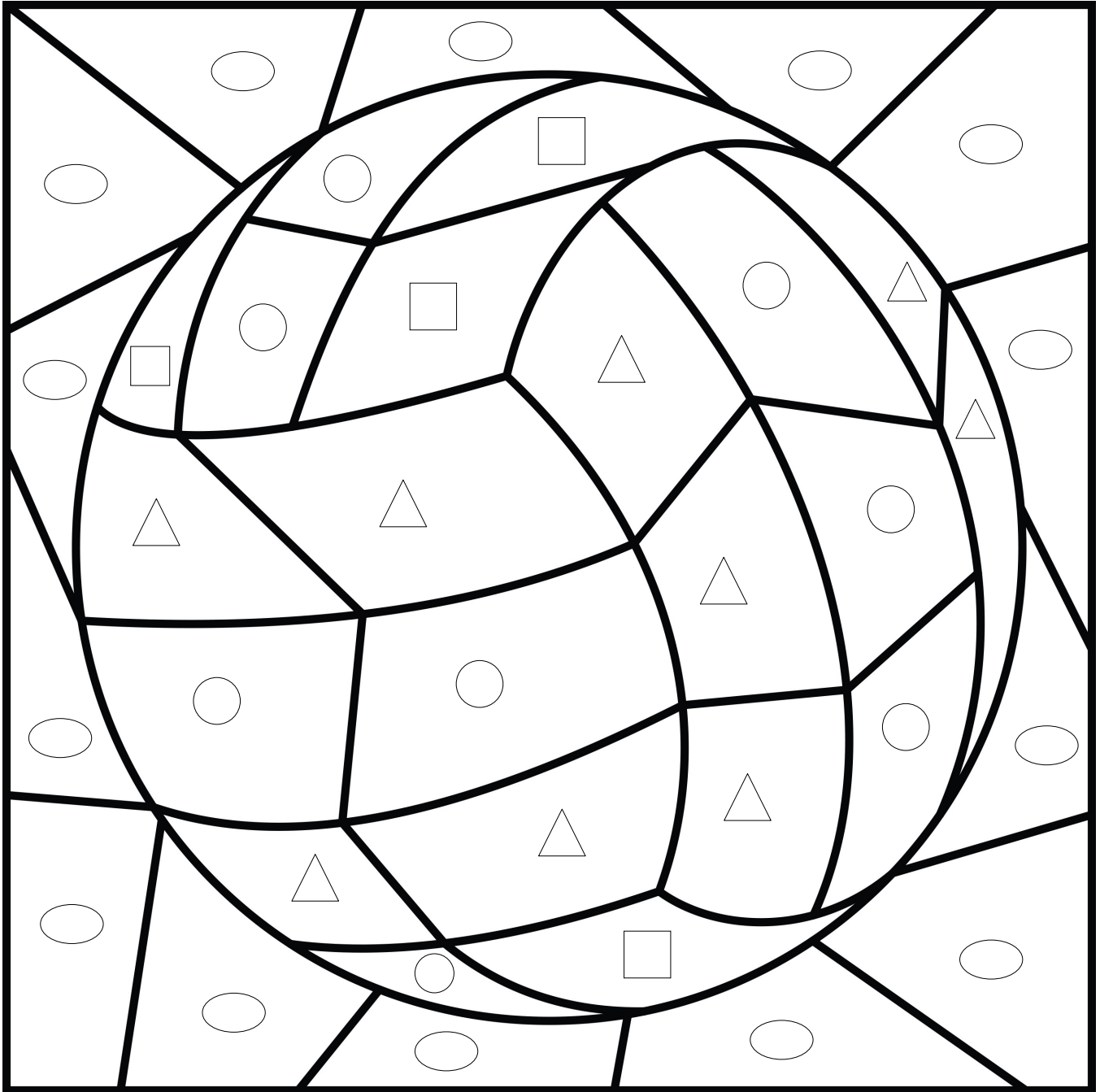


Let's Be Weather Forecasters
