Its people are part of more than 2,500 different people groups. A people group is a group of people who share things like the same language or history or geographic area they live in. You'll find India in South Asia, stretching out into the Arabian Sea and the Indian Ocean. It is neighbors with Bangladesh, Bhutan, Burma, China, Nepal, and Pakistan.

India is divided into thirty-six different regions. Twenty-nine of the regions are called states and seven are called union territories. We'll travel to four cities in four different states today. Are you ready? Let's get started. Our first stop is Agra.
