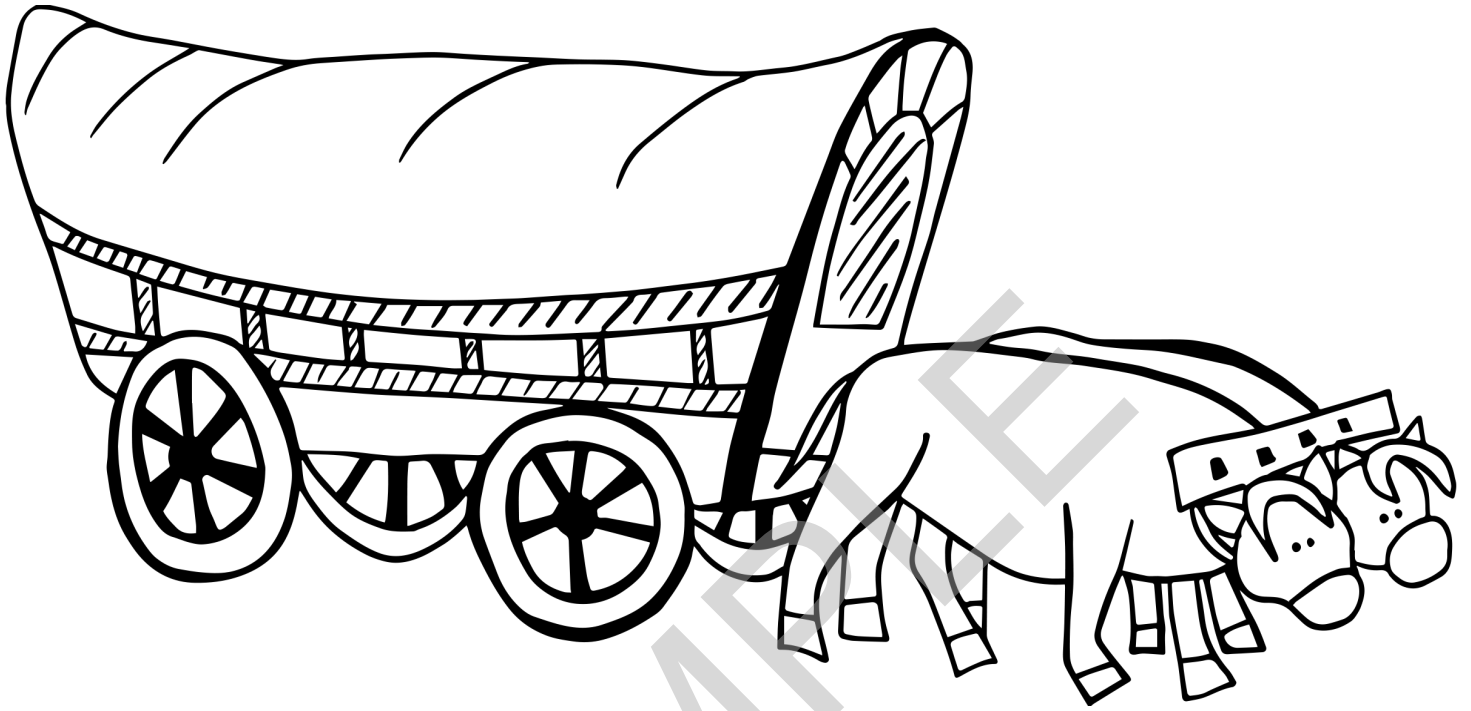




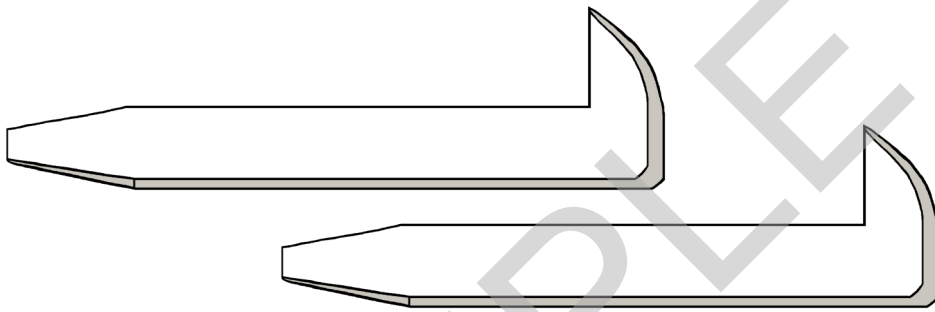
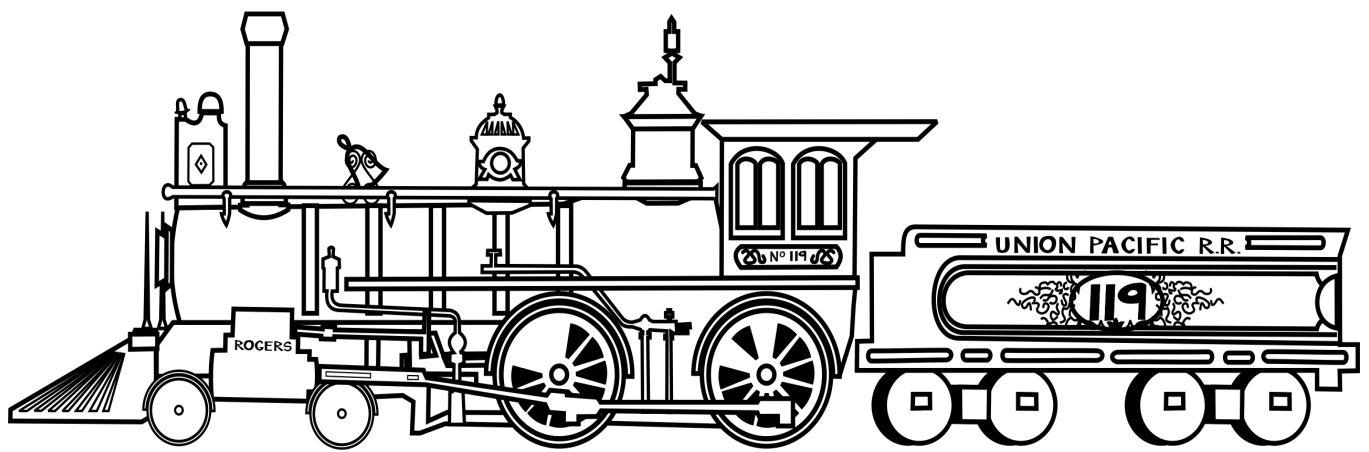
In 1783, the United
