Noun — Verb — Pronoun — Adjective
Adverb — Preposition — Conjunction

Noun	word for a person, place, or thing
Verb	word that shows action or state of being
Pronoun	word used in place of a noun
Adjective	word that modifies or describes a noun or a pronoun
Adverb	word that helps more fully describe a verb, adjective, or another adverb
Preposition	works with a noun or pronoun to show a relationship between words
Conjunction	connects words, phrases, clauses, or sentences
Possessive	the way a word is written to show ownership of something
Contraction	shorten a word or combine words by using an apostrophe to replace one or more letters
Inflection	change that helps determine a word's meaning
