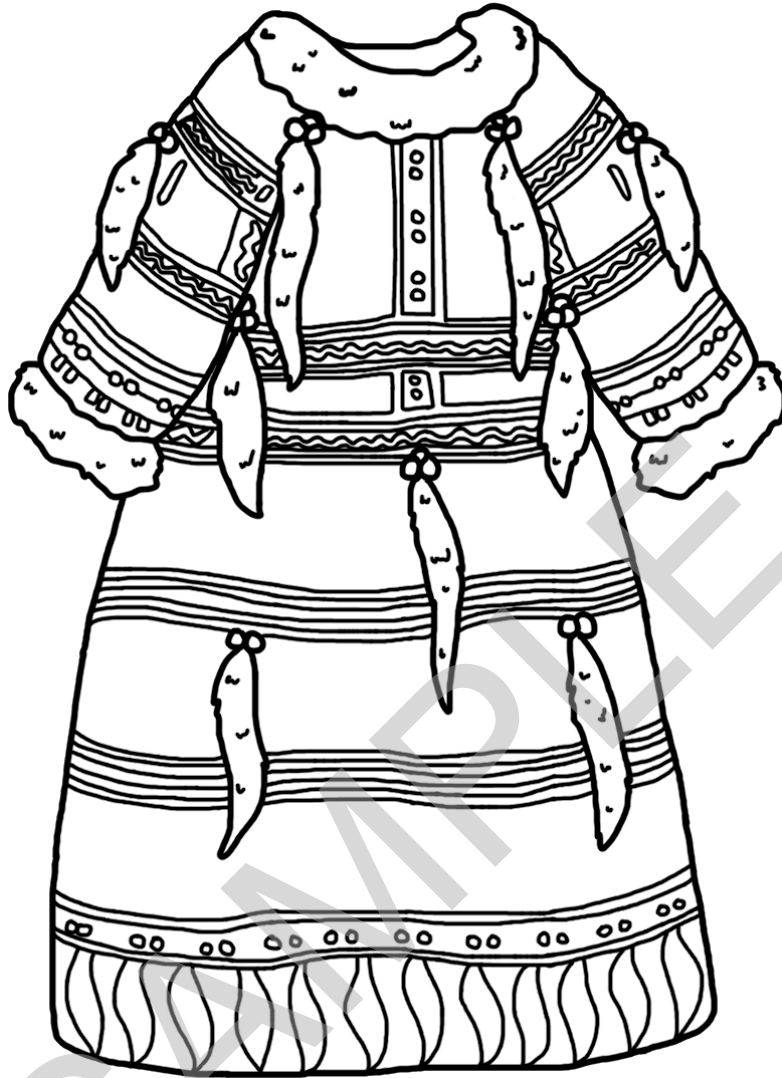


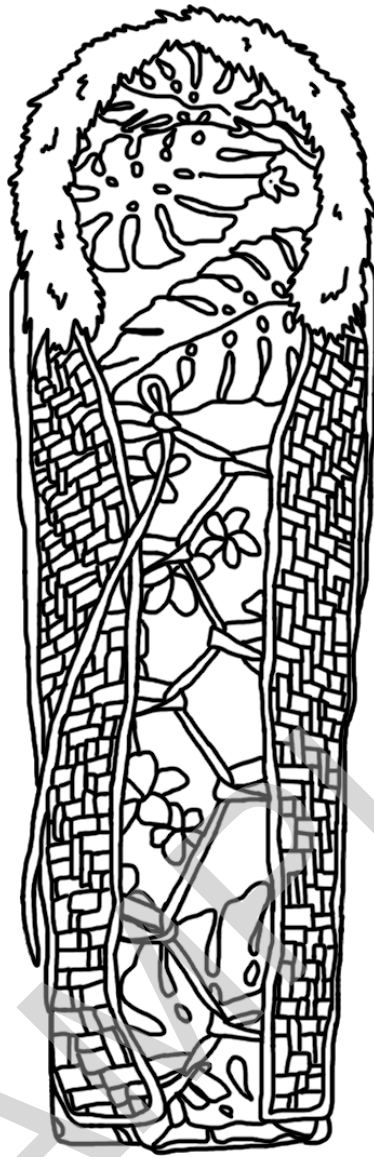
Alut women were
