Alchemist	one who combined magic tricks and chemistry to seemingly change one thing to another
Apprentice	one who works for another in exchange for learning a trade or skill
Artisan	a very skilled craftsman
Ballista	looks like a bow and arrow on a stand; catapults spears long distances
Barbarian	one whose ways are different and thought to be inferior or uncivilized
Castle	home of a monarch or noble in the Middle Ages; often used for protection
Catapult	ancient weapon used to hurl stones and other objects at the enemy
Cathedral	large church where a bishop resides
Citadel	fortress or stronghold that protects and defends an area
Crossbow	weapon that shot arrows from a short bow attached to a longer piece of wood
