

## Animal Parts Terminology

Abdomen — Adductor — Antennae — Antlers  
Beak — Carapace — Cephalothorax  
Chelicerae — Down — Flight feathers

Abdomen	the last section of an arthropod's body; located behind the thorax
Adductor	strong muscle used by some bivalves to pull their shells together very tightly
Antennae	slender organs used by some animals for sensing
Antlers	pair of bony growths on the head of a member of the deer family
Beak	the hard part that covers a bird's mouth; bill
Carapace	hard shell on the back of certain animals
Cephalothorax	part of some animals that includes the head and thorax
Chelicerae	pair of mouth parts of an arachnid
Down	small fluffy feathers found between the outer feathers on some birds
Flight feathers	long, large feathers on a bird's wings and tail


