

# Print & Cursive Connections: Energy & Its Many Forms

This unit is designed to help young writers see the connection between print and cursive by practicing them together. In the first pages of the unit, each word is stacked so that print is immediately followed by cursive. Students then trace the words in the same pattern. Finally, students write both words following the pattern. After the thirty-one individual terms, students practice thirty-one complete sentences using the same pattern.

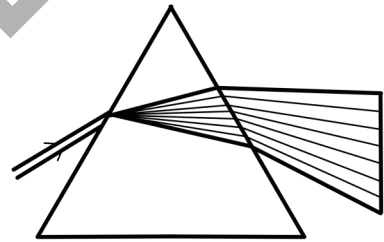
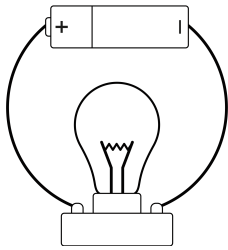
