

Date Dash: Asia

Welcome to Date Dash: Asia, the board game that tests your knowledge of Asian history! Date Dash: Asia is a multiple-choice game designed to test your knowledge of the history of twelve Asian countries.

Before You Start:

Choose whether you will play Date Dash Level 1 or Date Dash Level 2. (Date Dash Level 1 tests the players' general knowledge of history. Example: Christopher Columbus discovered the New World in: 1192, **1492**, or 1992. Date Dash Level 2 tests the players' specific knowledge of history. Example: Christopher Columbus discovered the New World in: 1490, **1492**, or 1496.) The correct answer is bolded.

Decide if players will mark the spaces as they get questions correct (if the pages will not be reused) or gather small markers, buttons, etc. to put on spaces to mark correct answers. Each player should have a distinct color or style of marker, and caution should be used so that markers are not choking hazards.

Basic Rules:

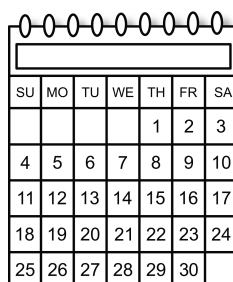
The first player draws a card from the Q&A stack and reads the question to the player on his or her left. If the player answers the question correctly, they mark a dash or place a marker on the first space on their calendar board. Their turn ends, and they draw the next card to ask the player on their left. If they answer incorrectly, their turn ends, and they draw the next card to ask the player on their left.

Variations of Play:

Single Country: Print one copy of the questions and one copy of the calendar page pertaining to the country whose history you want to answer questions from. The first player to place seven markers for seven correct answers wins. If more than four players are playing, print additional copies of the calendar page.

Single Month: Print one copy of all the questions and one copy of the Asia calendar page. Shuffle the questions together. When reading the questions, it is suggested to read the name of the country the question refers to. The first player to place seven markers for seven correct answers wins. If more than four players are playing, print additional copies of the calendar page.

Full Game: Print one copy of all the questions and one copy of the twelve individual calendar pages. Keep the questions separated by country. Play one country at a time. Whenever a player answers seven questions on one country correctly, they win that calendar page. Once all twelve calendar pages have been won, the person with the most calendar pages wins.
