

Reading Maps Decoding

Since it helps to have two points to find a location on a map, we are going to find the names of map terms by finding each letter of each name in the graph, then writing the letter. Follow the directions for finding each letter. For example, if the directions say Across 4, Down 3, (A4-D3), follow the Down row 3 over to Across column 4 and find the letter **e**. In the instructions, we will use A for Across and D for Down.


