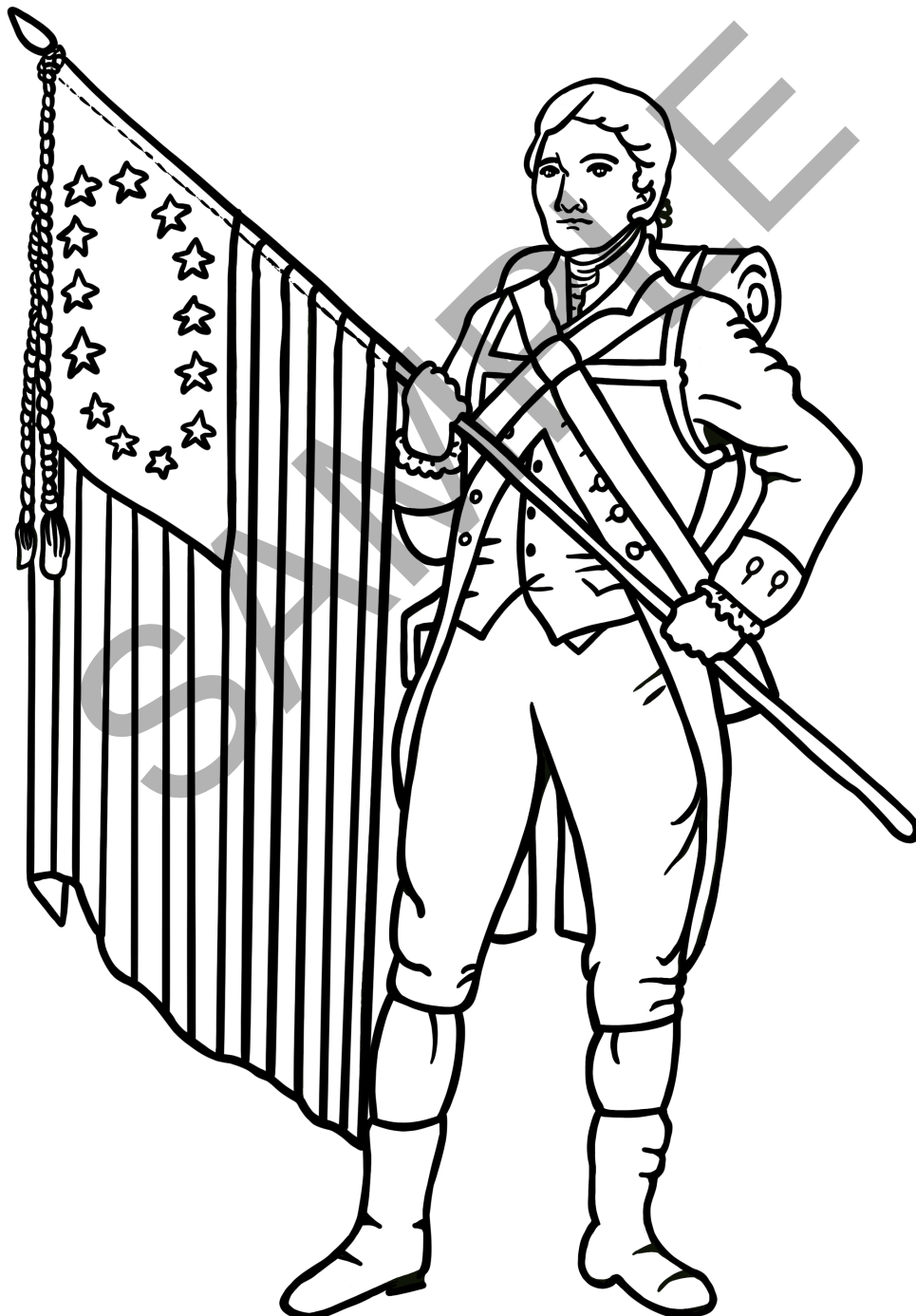


Print & Cursive Connections: American Revolution, Volume 2
