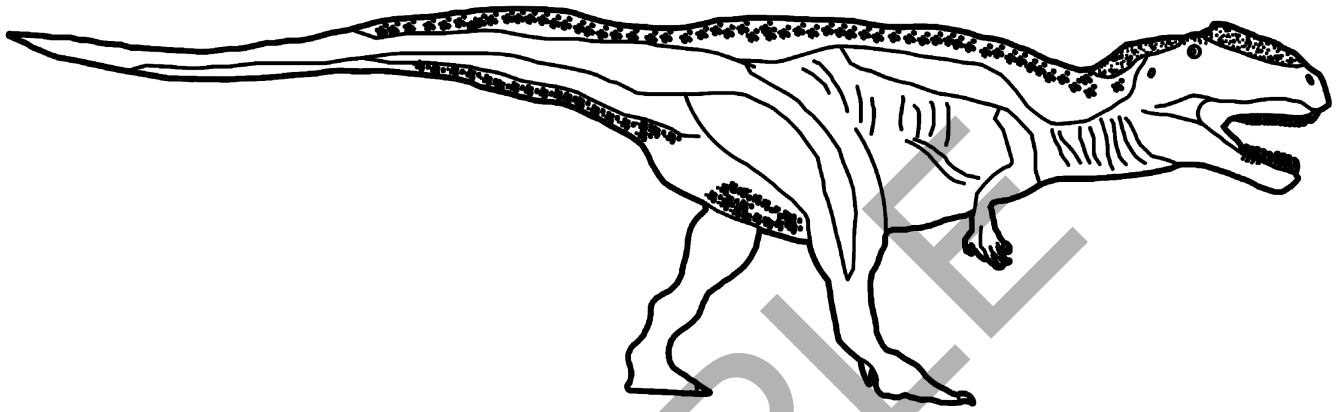
Not only did the

long teeth, . . .



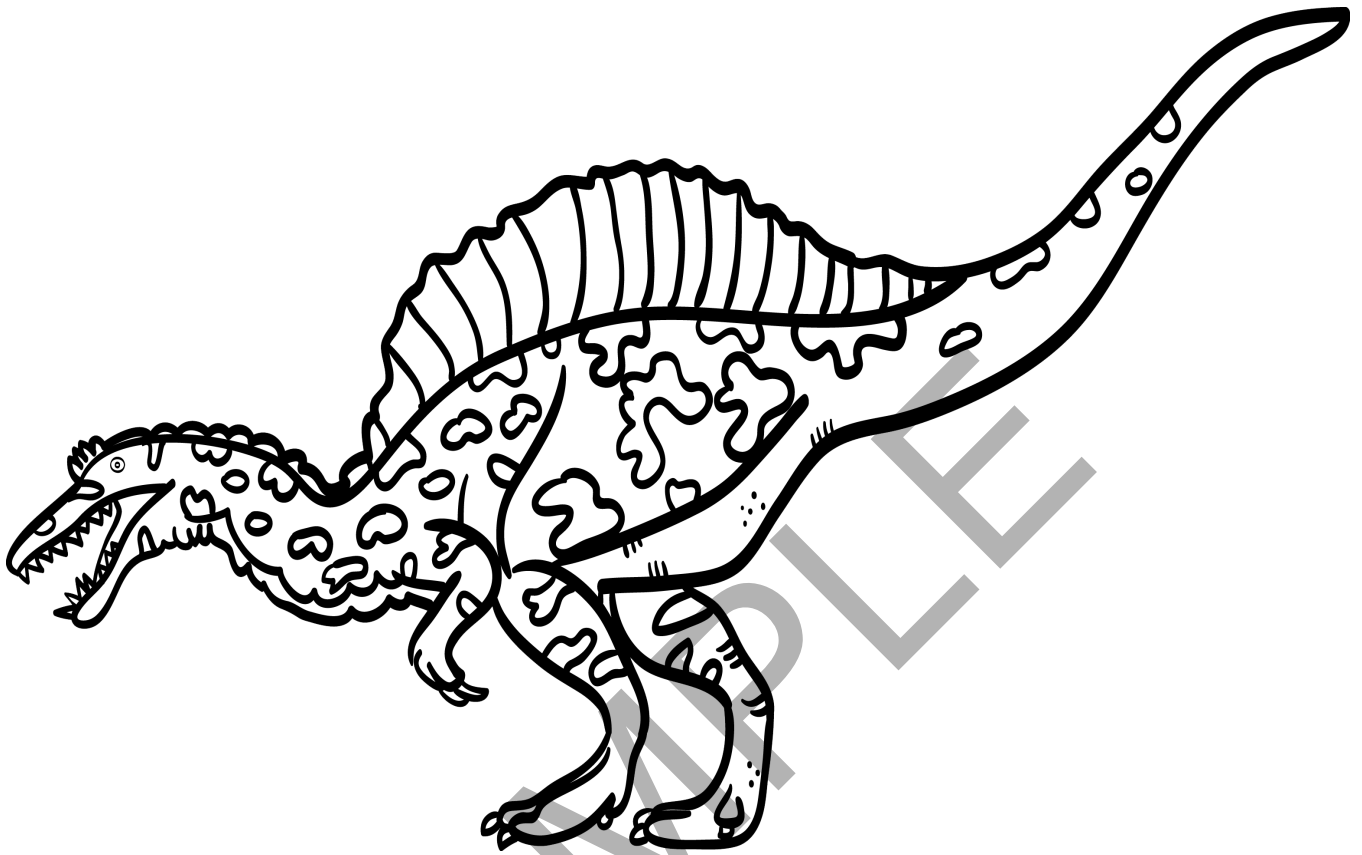
it could bite down

other dinosaur, . . .



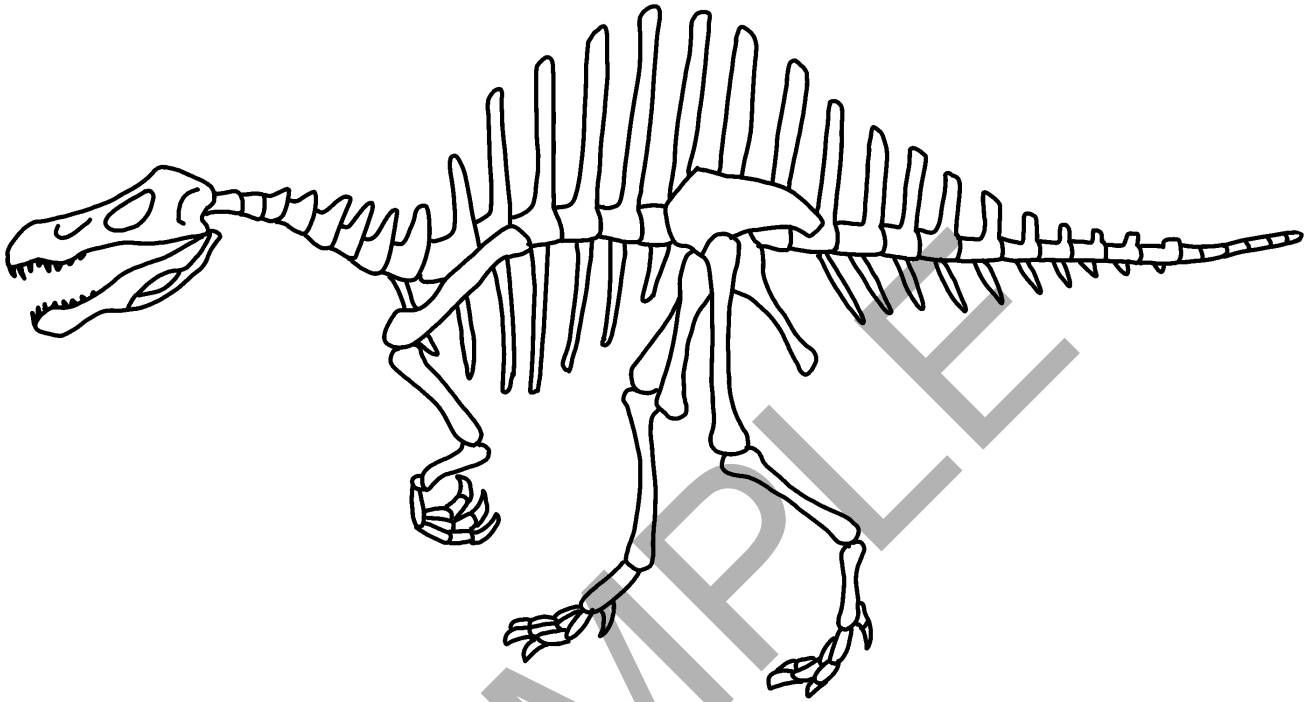
which helped it bite
