

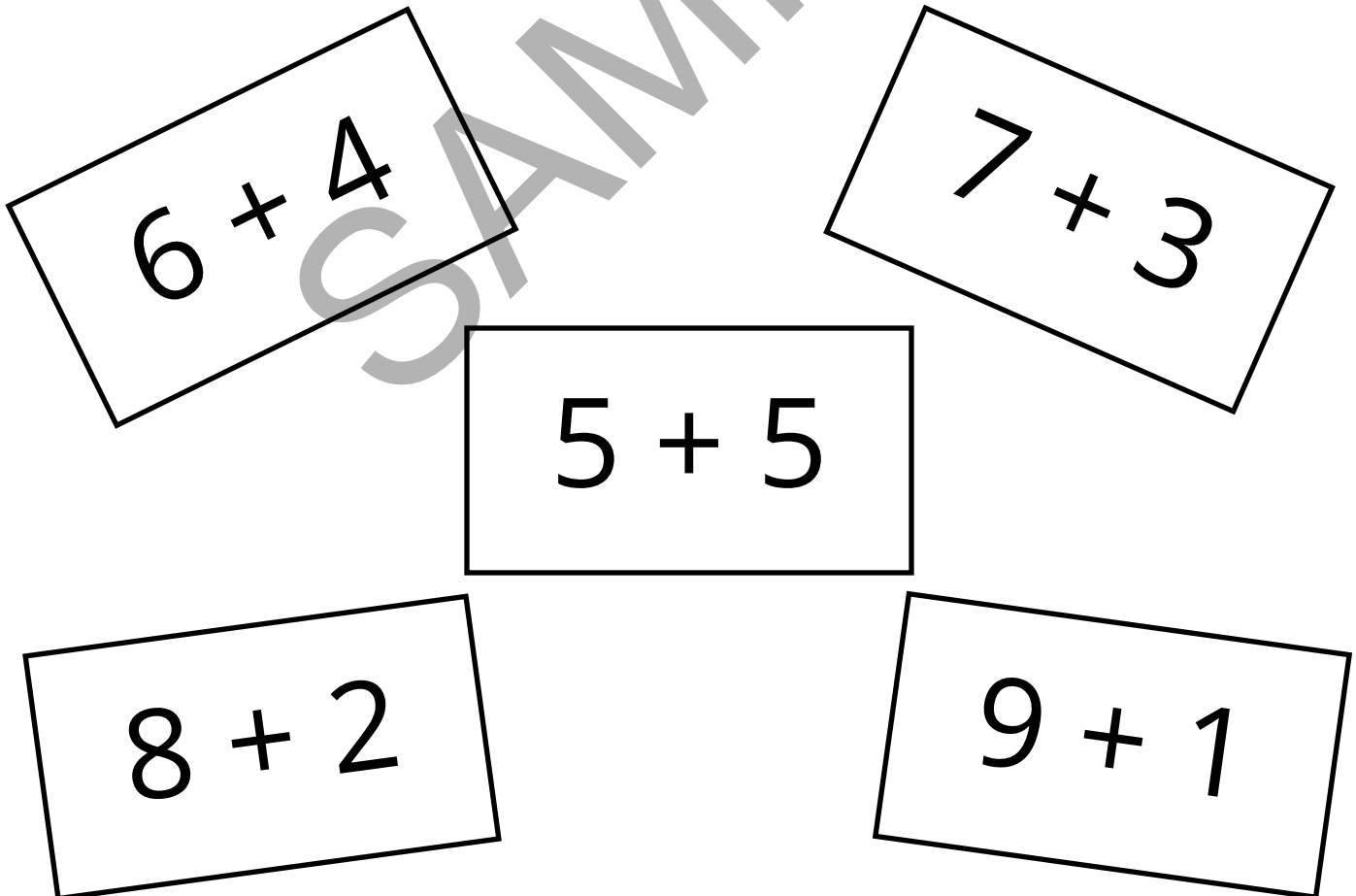
## Instructions for Clip Cards

Clip cards are a fun way to practice many things. You can use these math clip cards to help young students learn how different addition problems can equal the same number. These cards contain different problems whose answers range from 1 to 20. The answers are not shown on the cards. By doing mental math, the student can match the two problems with the same answer.

First, print the clip cards. They will hold up longer if they are printed on card stock and laminated, but they will work just as well if they are printed on paper.

After you've printed them, cut out the cards along the outside lines. There are four clip cards on each page, so be careful to cut the card that has the large math problem and the three selections of problems beneath it together as one card.

Give the student one clip card and a clothespin. Have the student read the math problem on the top of the card or read the math problem to them. Have them clip the clothespin on the math problem whose answer is the same as the answer to the top problem.
