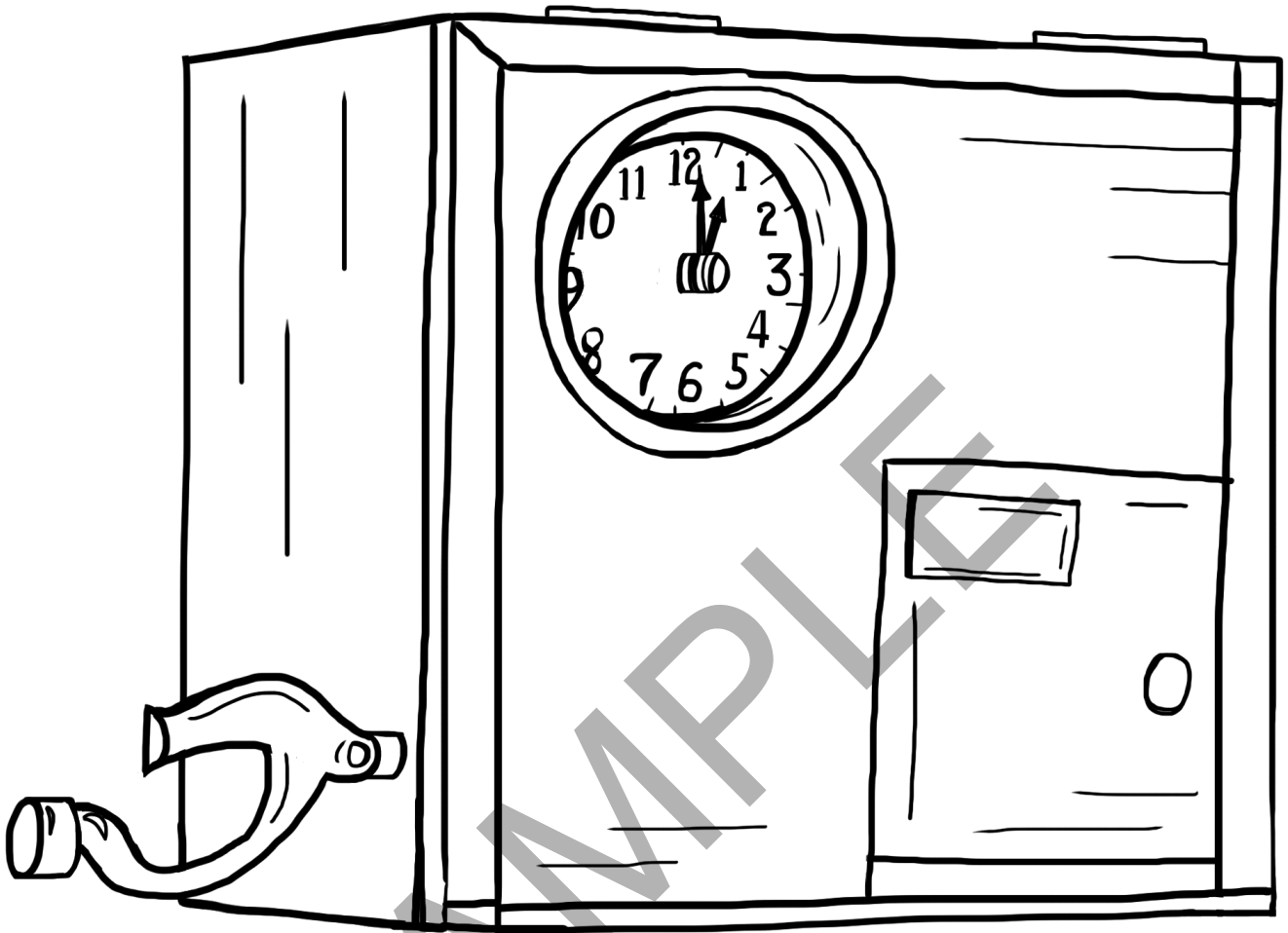


With the wood

he got back to

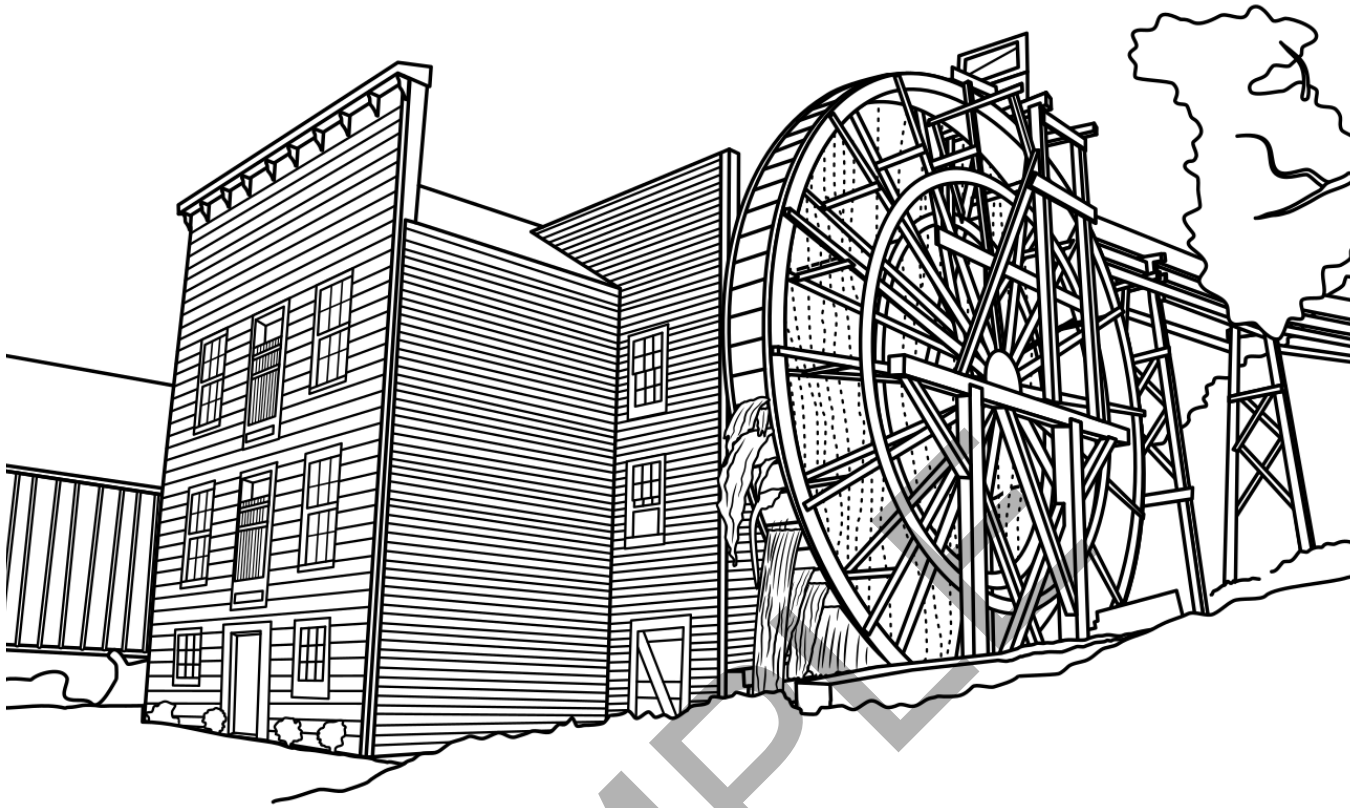
work carving.
