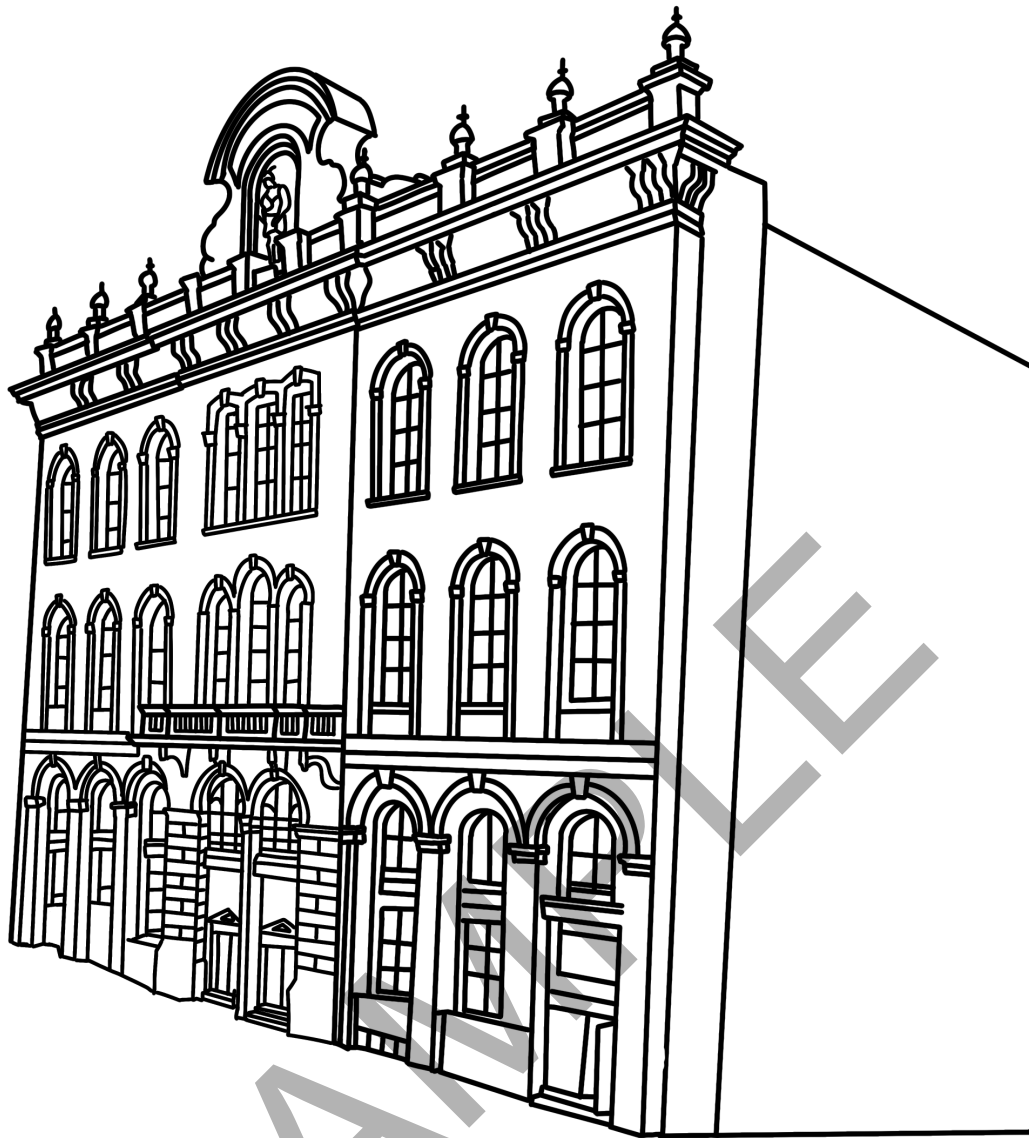
He became governor  
of New York in 1882.



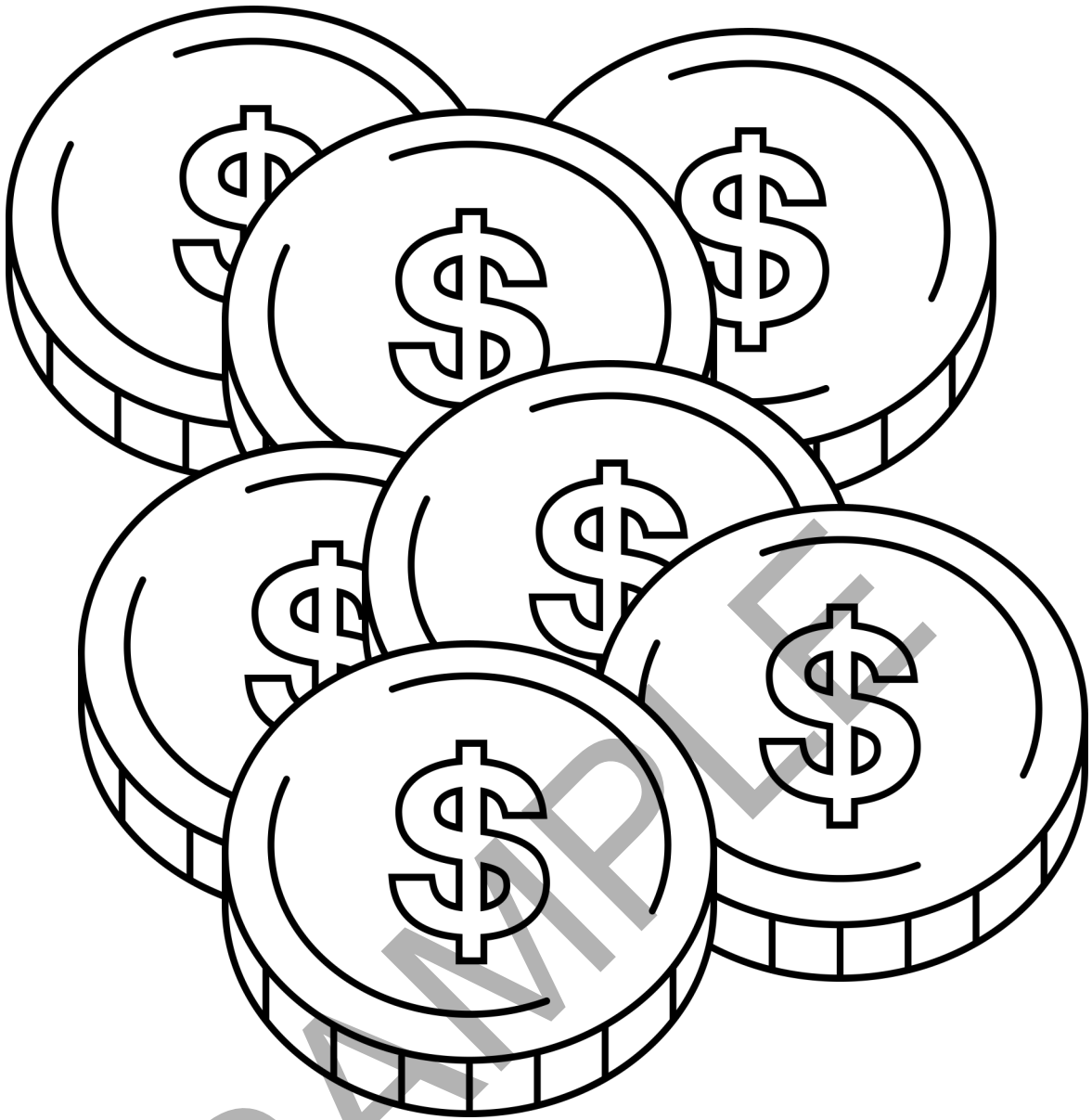
He was a Democrat
