Getting an Aquarium Ready

Do you like to watch fish in an aquarium? Do you think fish make good pets? It takes a lot of work to get ready to have fish as pets, and it takes a lot of work to take care of them, too.

First, start with an empty aquarium.

Next, you need soil for the bottom of the aquarium. You also need a filter. The filter helps keep the water clean so your fish don't get sick as easily.

You can add decorations to hide the equipment and make the aquarium look nice, too. Now you can add the water and plants.

Don't forget to get a light for your aquarium so you can see the fish any time of the day.

You also need a water conditioner to add to the water to make it safe for the fish.

You also need to get a siphon to clean the gravel after the fish have been in the aquarium!

Are you ready to get your fish?

First, you need to go to a pet store and get a fish carrier to take your fish home in.

Next, make sure you have food ready to feed your fish when you bring them home.

You also need vitamins to help keep your fish healthy. Different kinds of fish need different vitamins, so be sure you get the right kind for the fish you are getting.

Be sure you get a net so you can carefully put the fish in the aquarium.

Make sure your aquarium is ready. Sometimes an aquarium needs to sit for a few hours or days, depending on the kind of fish, before you can put your fish in it for the first time.

Now, pick out your fish, take them home, and enjoy them!

Life Cycle of a Fish

Fish can be fun to watch. Here are some of the steps in a fish's life cycle.

Fish begin as eggs. There are often many eggs produced at one time depending on the type of fish.

A fish starts out very small in the egg. It gets its food from the yolk of the egg.

The baby fish grows while it is still inside the egg.

When it hatches, it is called a larva or fry. A larva doesn't have very developed fins yet.

The larva continues to grow and develop. It starts to look more and more like the adult fish it will become.


Finally, it becomes an adult. This can take years for large fish or minutes for very tiny fish. For fish like guppies and some minnows, it usually takes a few months.






Life Cycle of a Fish








