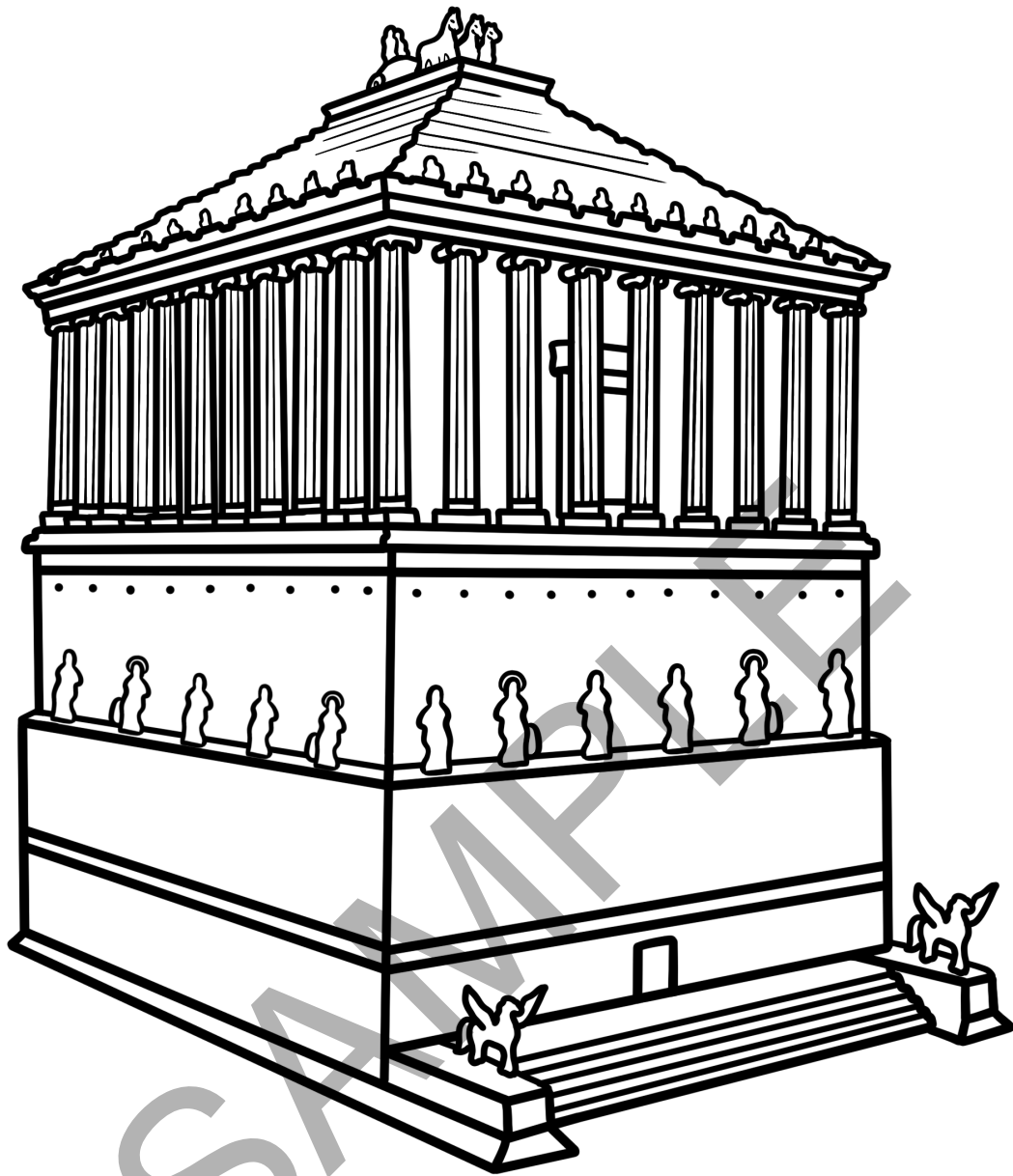

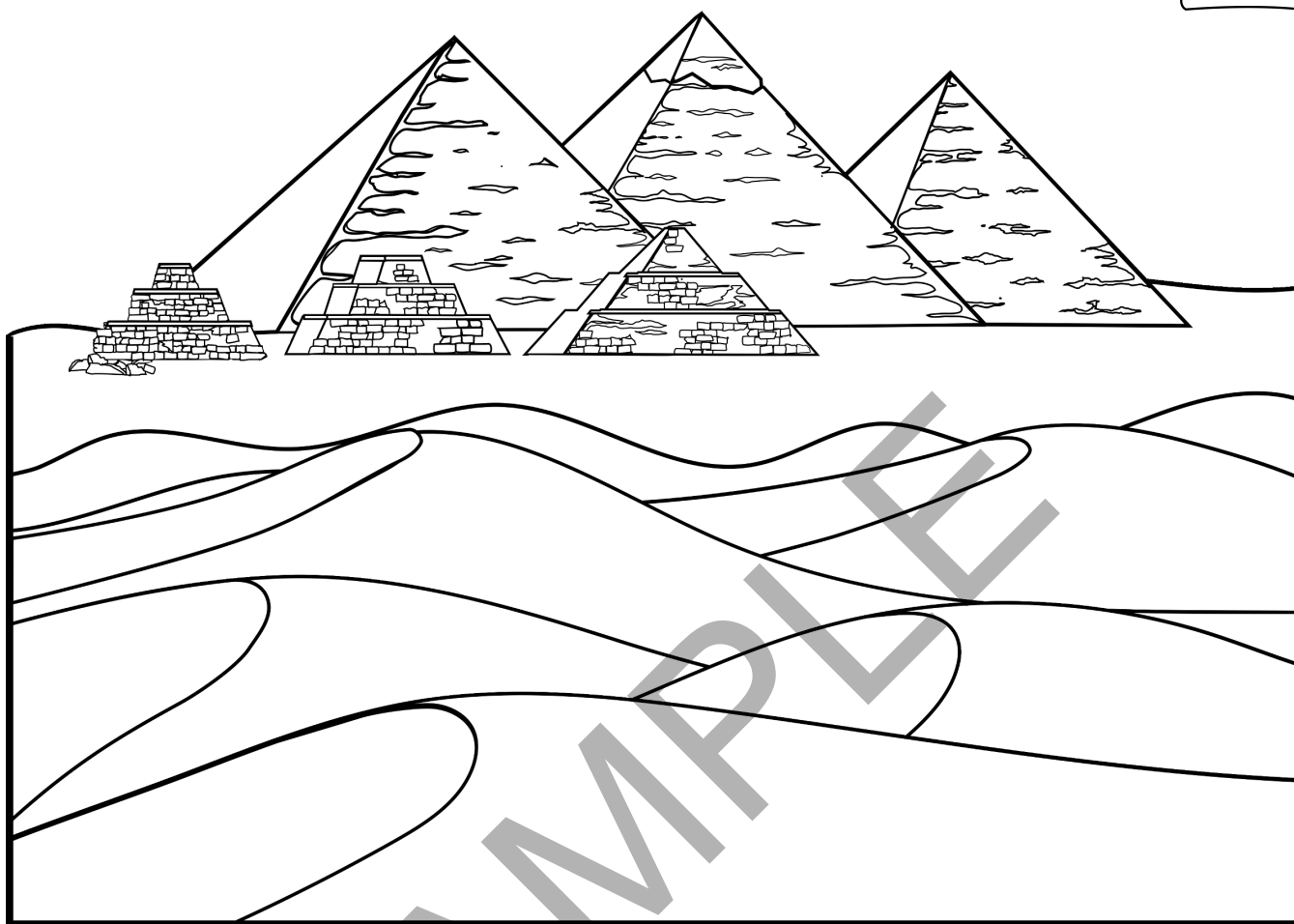
These wonders will

on their pages.



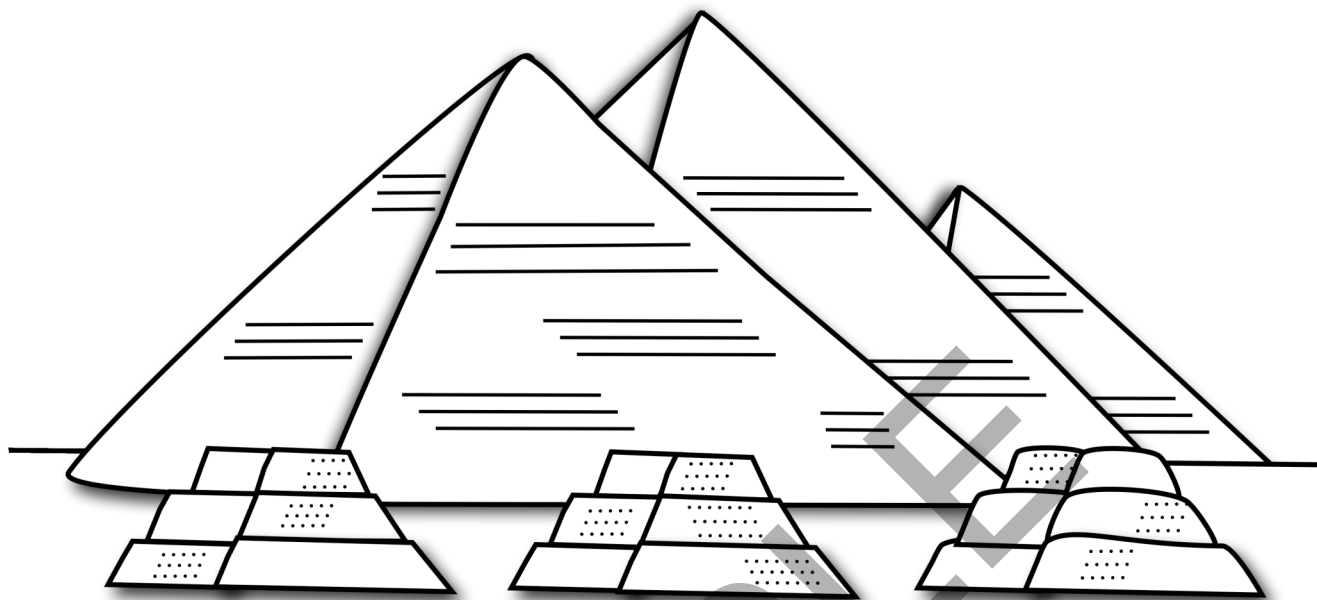
A few were called

pyramids.

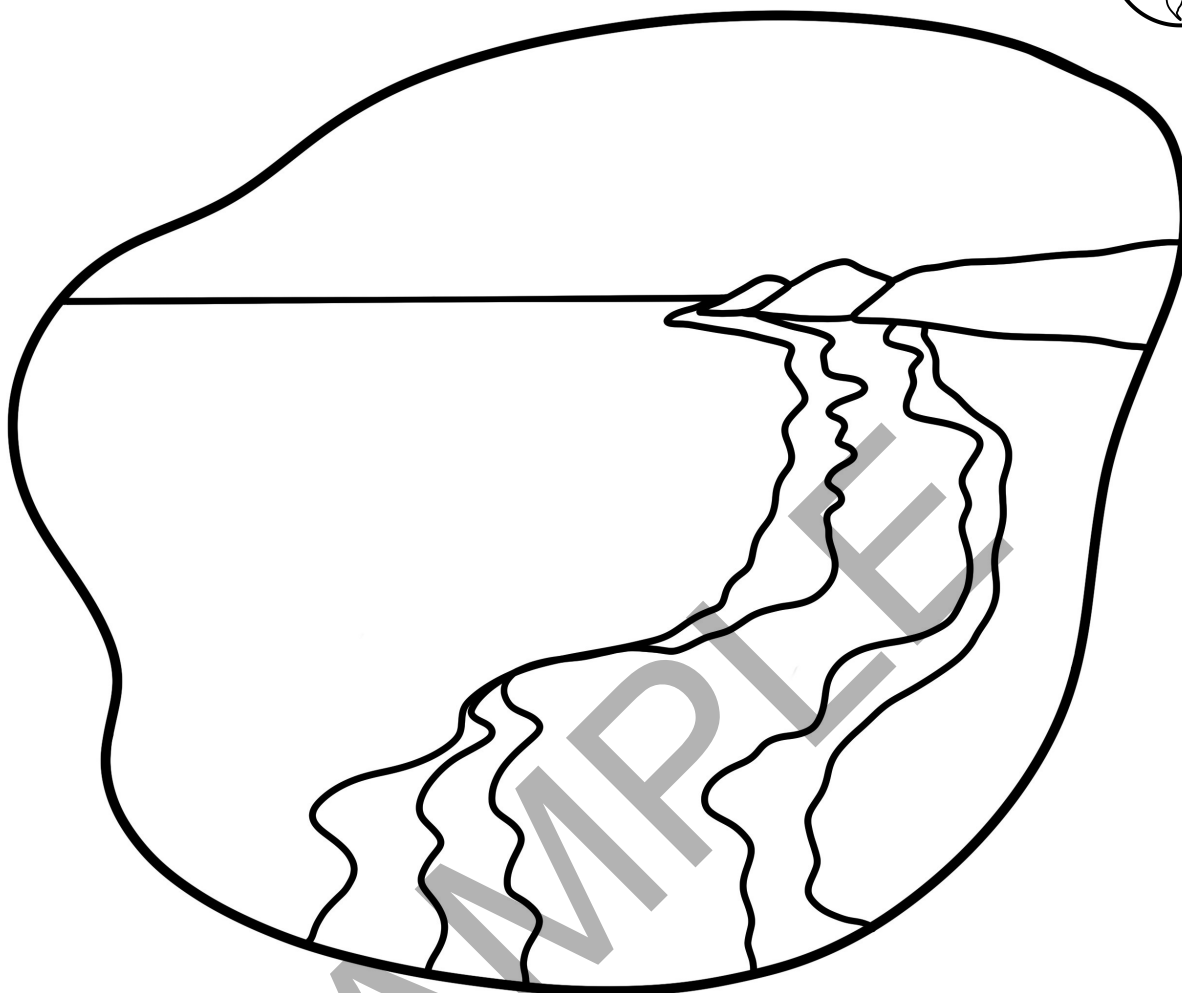


Built as tombs for
